

Who Is Required to Report

 Any U.S. Certificated or Commuter Carrier that operates Scheduled Passenger Service and issues tickets for passenger travel are required to report

 To note, Carriers may use a third-party vendor but are not required to

Carrier Requirements to Report

The new rule creates two categories for determining which carrier is responsible for submission to the Department:

- Category 1 ticket is submitted by the carrier that issued the ticket when that carrier appears on the published O&D Reporting Carrier List
- Category 2 ticket is submitted by the first lifting operating carrier that is on the published O&D Reporting Carrier List when the issuing carrier does not appear on the list

Reporting Carrier List

- 'Preliminary Reporting Carrier List' posted to: https://www.bts.gov/OD-40-reporting-carrier-list
- Will be updated as carriers start/stop operations
- OAI will publish a Reporting Carrier List 75 days prior to the beginning of each period of reporting.

Data Submission via eSubmit Portal or SFTP

- eSubmit Portal
 - Accepts CSV file or ZIP folder containing one or more CSV files, up to five
 - For new reporting carriers, visit https://esubmit.rita.dot.gov/. We will provide a user guide and technical support during setup.
 - For existing customers, it's identical to the current OD submission but will be under the new rule.
- Secure File Transfer Protocol (SFTP)
 - Data submissions can now be securely transmitted via SFTP
 - Supports many SFTP clients
 - Accepts CSV files or ZIP folders containing one or more CSV files, up to five
 - We will provide a user guide and technical support during setup.

Volunteer to submit test data through eSubmit or SFTP

Data Validation

- The O&D data is validated against:
 - Schedule data during processing, which will be even more important to elements in the new system. Carriers will need to ensure they have all their schedule data, including all code share arrangements, loaded with their schedule provider.
 - T100-Traffic Data
- Total Amount not greater than \$50,000 or less than \$0
- Tax Amount not greater than \$1,999 or less than \$0

Data Validation

- Total Amount cannot be less than Tax Amount
- Operating/Marketing Carriers are either hyphen hyphen ("- -") for Surface segments or TRN/BUS for ticketed segments for operating carrier and the carrier code for the marketing carrier
- Year 4 digits; Month 2 digits; Airports 3 characters
- Dwell Time valid values: 1-1440, 9999, -1, and 'B'
- Purchase Window Group 2290, 21AP, 91UP
- Destination appears in the Airport Code column after the last coupon segment (Scheduled Year/Month are to be blank in the last coupon).

Data Validation

- On https://esubmit.rita.dot.gov/OD-US-40.aspx, there is a sample data file that can be reviewed as your carrier is developing their file for future submission
 - Data set contains examples of different types of itineraries
 - If carrier comes across a scenario not defined, please let us know
- If your carrier would like feedback on the upcoming data submission, please contact <u>OAI.OD40.Support@dot.gov</u>.

Please send an Excel file with about 1000 rows of data.

- OAI will review and provide feedback on what is going well and what are potential issues
- OAI will help carriers address issues before official data submission begins


