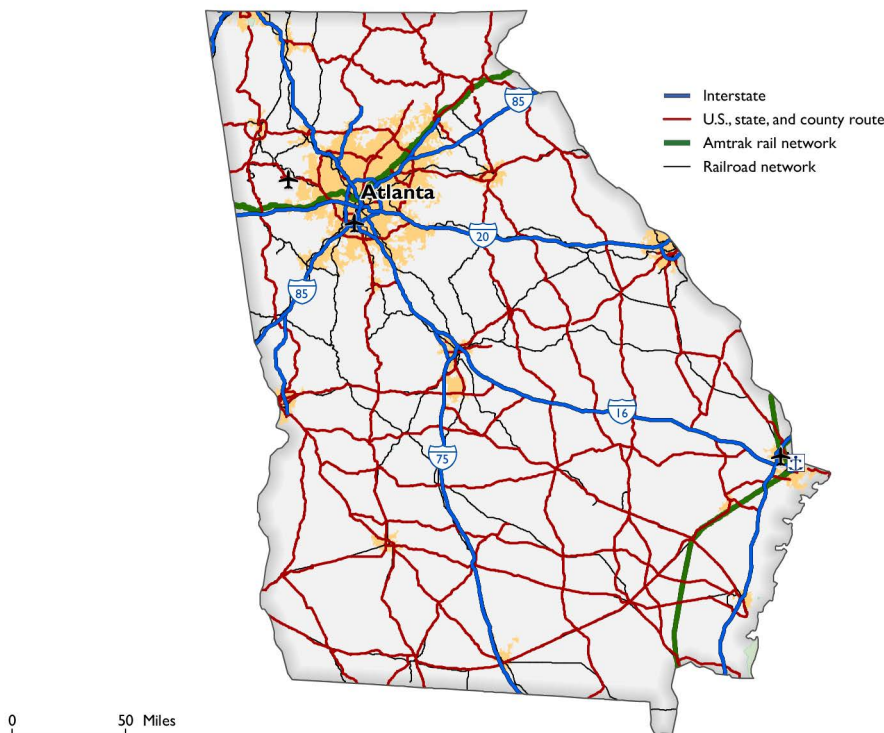

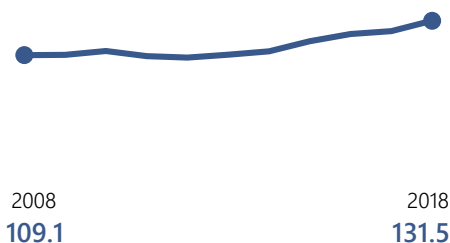

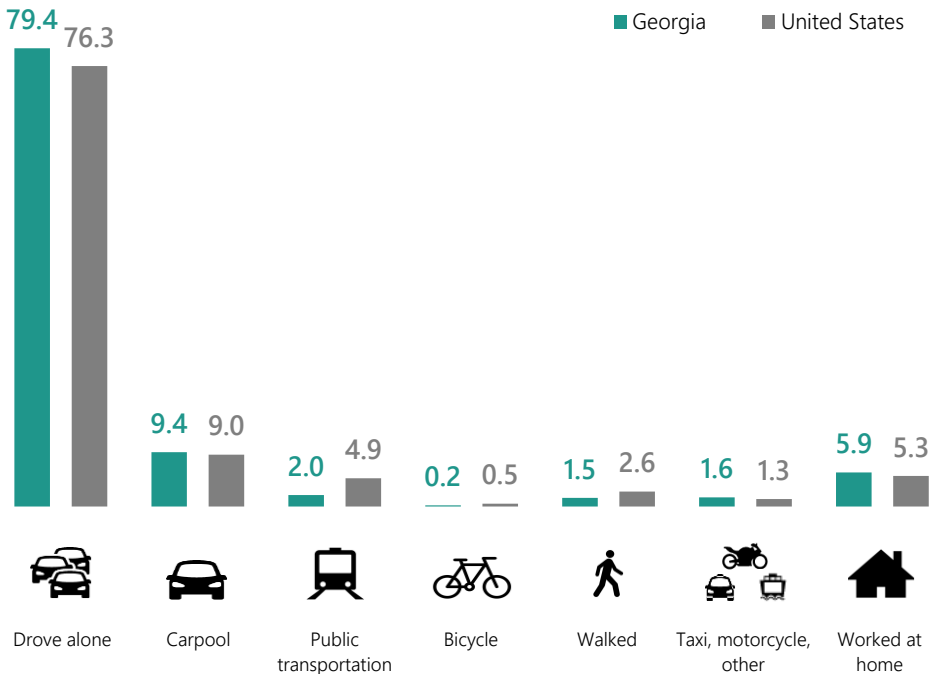

Miles per person per day, 2017



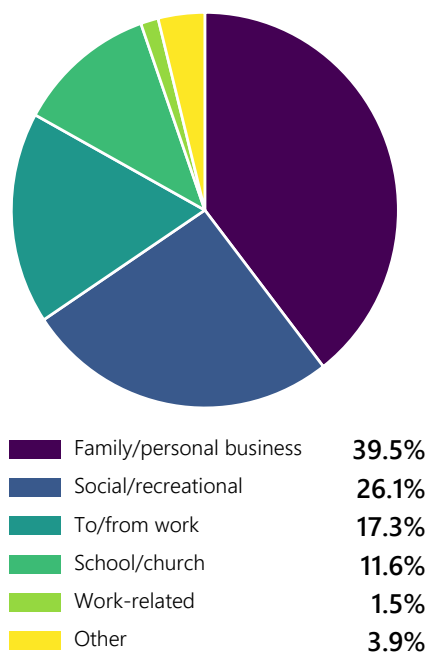
AVERAGE DAILY PERSON TRIPS

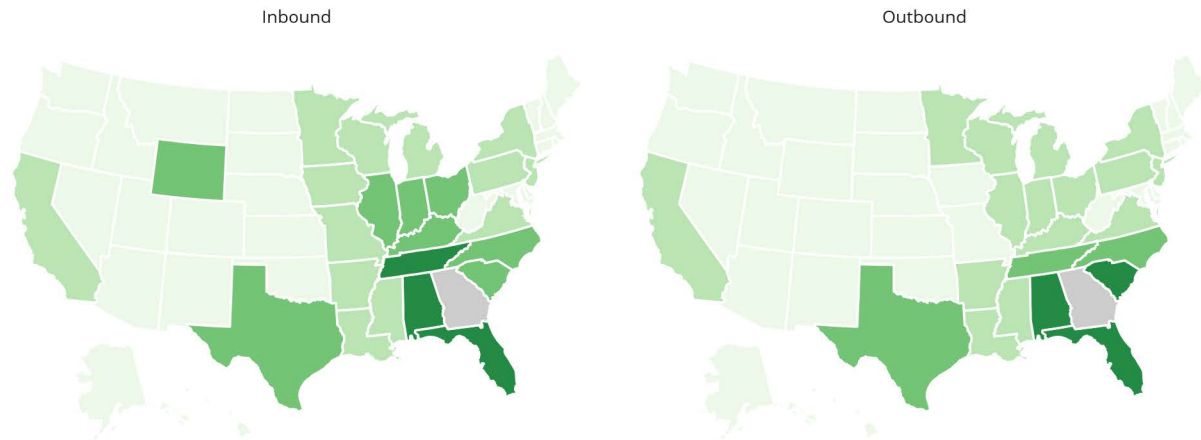

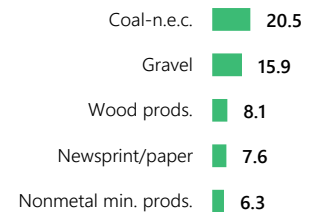
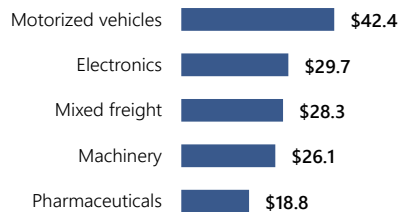

TOP COMMODITIES SHIPPED FROM GEORGIA

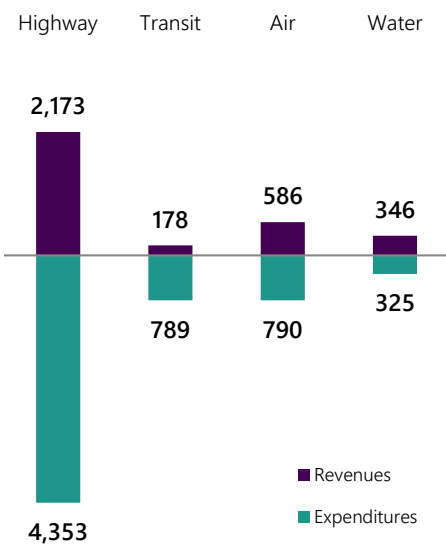

STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT TRANSPORTATION REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES

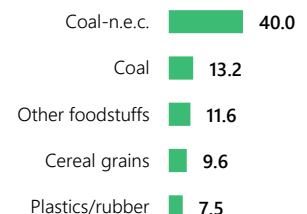
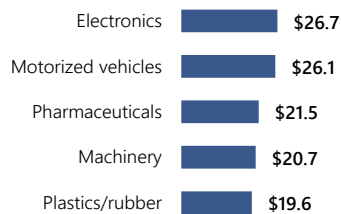

By value moved in billions of current dollars, 2018

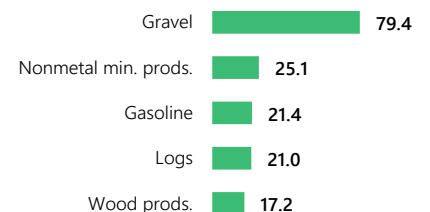
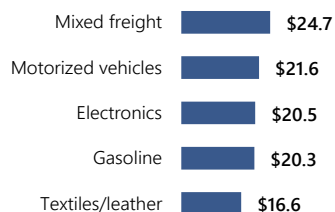
By weight moved in millions of tons, 2018

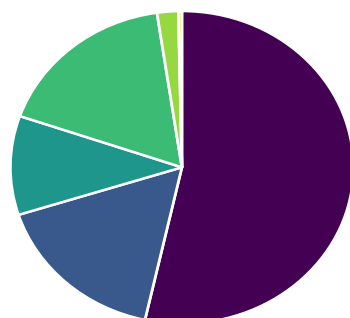

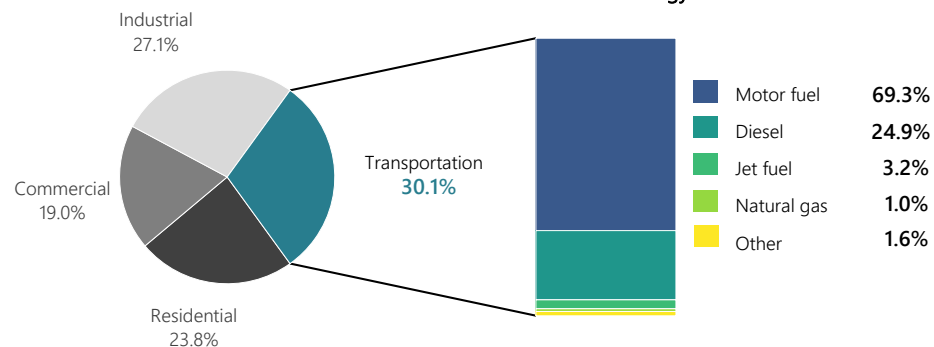

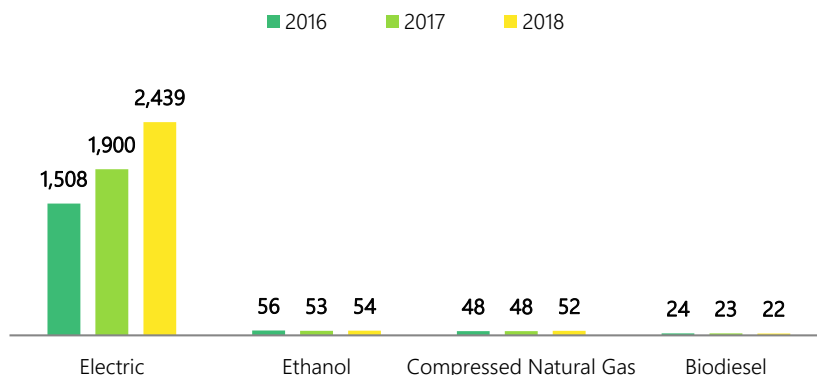
