











By value moved in billions of current dollars, 2018


By weight moved in millions of tons, 2018






STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT **TRANSPORTATION REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES**



Fatalities per 100 million vehicle miles traveled, 2018




HIGHWAY FATALITIES BY PERSON


HIGHWAY MOTOR FUEL USE PER CAPITA
