











Fatalities per 100 million vehicle miles traveled, 2018




### **HIGHWAY FATALITIES BY PERSON**

Percent of Btu consumed, 2017




### TRANSPORTATION ENERGY USE


# HIGHWAY MOTOR FUEL USE PER CAPITA
