








# STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT TRANSPORTATION REVENUES AND EXPENDITURES



Fatalities per 100 million vehicle miles traveled, 2018




# **HIGHWAY FATALITIES BY PERSON**

Percent of Btu consumed, 2017




#### TRANSPORTATION ENERGY USE


# HIGHWAY MOTOR FUEL USE PER CAPITA
